The Geneva Centre will produce daily analytical reports on selected meetings of the Human Rights Council

Due to the budgetary restrictions, in June 2019, **UNOG Information Service stopped producing meeting summaries** of the substantive discussions of the Human Rights Council. The lack of coverage is unprecedented since the beginning of the Council and, has already negatively impacted the work of permanent missions, civil society and other stakeholders.

To tackle this issue, starting from the **43rd session of the Human Rights Council** (24 February - 20 March 2020) the Geneva Centre for Human Rights Advancement and Global Dialogue will be producing concise analytical one-page reports on the meetings attended. The briefings will be published the same day.
