*During the 34th Meeting of the 43rd Regular Session of the Human Rights Council (13 March 2020):*

1. **All mandates and mandated activities** that would otherwise expire until the resumption of the 43rd session **were extended**;
2. **19 mandate holders** for the 43<sup>rd</sup> session **were appointed**;
3. Decisions on the **suspension of 43<sup>rd</sup> the session** was taken.
