2-30 September 2019: “Human rights in a multilateral context” a training programme for students of Zayed University, Dubai (UAE)

When: 2-30 September 2019

Who: three trainees – female students from Zayed University (UAE)

What: The trainees underwent a 4-week training programme entitled “Human rights in a multilateral context”. The programme included lectures, on the history, role and mission of the United Nations, functioning and role of the UN Human Rights Council, Introduction to International Human Rights Law, and the role of communication in the field of human rights.



2-13 March 2020 “Human rights in a multilateral context” a training programme for students of Zayed University, Dubai (UAE)

When: 2 to 13 March 2020 (the training should have lasted until 30 March but was suspended due to COVID-19)

Who: two trainees students from Zayed University (UAE)

What: An intensive 2-weeks training on Human Rights & International Law, Human Rights Council and UN Human Rights mechanisms, Gender issues, Women's rights and Interfaith dialogue. The trainees also attended the 43rd Session of the UN Human Rights Council.



17-19 September “Safety Ambassadors” a study visit of Dubai high-school students

When: 17 to 19 September 2019

Who: Four high-school students, participants of the Dubai Police Safety Ambassadors programme.

What: During this 3-day study visit, they received a training on the UN human rights mechanisms and the role and functions of the UN Human Rights Council.
